



JDT ISLAM ORPHANAGE

JDT, ESTABLISHED IN 1922, WAS ONE OF THE FIRST NGO ORPHANAGES TO EMERGE AS A PRODUCT OF INDIA'S FREEDOM STRUGGLE.


Jam'iyyat Da'wa Tablighul Islam, better known as the JDT Islam Orphanage, is a Registered Charitable Society and a non-profit organization. JDT Islam is one of the oldest orphanages in India, established in 1922 by Kasoori Brothers from Punjab for helping orphans and destitute, with its roots deeply intertwined with the freedom struggle. Its inception aimed to protect and save the children who became orphans and destitute as a result of the great Malabar Rebellion during the Indian Independence Struggle in 1921.



There is an interesting background as to how the JDT came into being. Prior to the setting up of the institution, a majority of the population in the region were living in abject poverty, except for a few landlords. The peasants had no right to their property except to cultivate after paying a fixed portion to the landlord as 'pattam'. What followed was the Malabar revolt of 1921 that left about 10,000 dead and thousands of children orphaned. Inspired by an article written in The Hindu by freedom fighter Mohammed Abdurehman, Abdul Khader Kasoori, a philanthropist from Lahore in the then undivided Punjab, went to Malabar in the 1920s and took up the initiative to purchase land and establish JDT, their first such initiative.

Going beyond the concept of merely providing food and shelter to the underprivileged, JDT Islam has explored the best ways to fulfil their needs and rights, including those related to health and education. Currently, there are 27 educational institutions under JDT Islam, with over 20,000 students, offering education from primary level schooling to professional courses, catering to a broad segment of the community.

Even though it commenced functioning as an Orphanage, with the intention to shelter, feed and care for the unfortunate and miserable children, who were the offsprings of the bygone Malabar Rebellion, today, JDT Islam has journeyed a long way to attain its present position and status, as a well-run and well-maintained orphanage, known for its determination and dedication for its uncompromising quality of education, made possible through much hardships and trials earlier and was able to make its mark, winning a wider acceptance and acclaim in the whole of Malabar. It has also paved the way for the institution to enjoy an enviable level of status in society, both in the educational and service sectors.

Such has been the journey of the JDT group that it was bestowed with the National Award for Child Development by President Pranab Mukherjee in 2011.

Iqraa Hospital is owned by the JDT Islam Orphanage Committee NGO, which is registered under the Societies Act. IQRAA International Hospital & Research Centre was established in 2000 as a healthcare initiative of JDT Islam. It serves as the sole healthcare initiative of the JDT Islam Orphanage Committee. IQRAA's strategy of providing value-based healthcare services has been successful in addressing the health and healthcare needs of the community. IQRAA has firmly established itself as a major philanthropic and charitable initiative, extending a helping hand to the needy population in the region, particularly the marginalized sections.

After 2000, the JDT Islam campus has experienced remarkable growth, particularly in the fields of education and healthcare. This expansion has seen the establishment of several notable institutions, including the College of Nursing, the College of Pharmacy, and the College of Physiotherapy. IQRAA International Hospital and Research Centre is a charitable healthcare initiative founded in 2000 by JDT Islam Orphanage Committee, Calicut, an NGO and one of the oldest orphanages in India. The objective of the hospital is to deliver high-quality healthcare services at affordable cost.

Even though a charitable institution, IQRAA provides state-of-the-art diagnostic and treatment facilities made affordable to people from all sections of society. Located in Calicut city, IQRAA is accredited with NABH and has an in-patient capacity of 450 beds with multispecialty departments. We have an excellent crew consisting of more than 180 Doctors, 1636 staff including 1371 Nursing and Paramedical staff. Our laboratory was awarded the prestigious accreditation of NABL in 2012 and we are still maintaining the certification. Professional expertise, qualified and experienced staff and socially committed management could lead IQRAA to new heights, within the decade of its establishment. The blood bank in the hospital has a separate NABH accreditation and it one of the first blood bank in Malabarto be NABH accredited.

We offer basic specialties like General Medicine, Obstetrics and Gynecology, Paediatrics, Orthopaedics, ENT, Dermatology, Dental surgery etc. along with super specialties like Cardiology, Nephrology, Urology, Endocrinology, Neurology etc. We provide laparoscopic surgery across all specialties. Our dermatology and cosmetology department delivers specialized services in vitiligo treatment including surgery, hair transplantation and cuttingedge cosmetology procedures. Orthopedics specialty regularly conducts joint replacement surgery, spine surgeries, scoliosis correction etc. In maternal and childcare, our centre is equipped with infertility treatment, high-risk pregnancy clinic, laparoscopic gynecological surgery unit and Level 3 Neonatology ICU.

Our Heart Centre is equipped with interventional cardiology services including Angioplasty. The Nephrology department is a centre of Excellence with more than 5000 dialysis a month. Kidney transplantation started in 2016 and on average 20 transplantation surgeries were performed in a month.

The hospital is recognized by Scientific And industrial Research organization (SIRO) of directorate of scientific and industrial research (DSIR) and our lab is certified by NABL for maintaining international standards in testing practices. IQRAA Hospital is a centre of Postgraduate Medical education running DNB Course with the accreditation of Ministry of Health and Family Welfare under the Government of India and conducting observership programme to doctors securing medical graduation abroad. We are running healthcare educational institutions for training professional in healthcare management, nursing, physiotherapy, imaging, laboratory technology etc. Our two decades of experience in healthcare sector, our way of being and doing, further enriches the commitment in delivering quality healthcare for one and all, combining professional excellence and charity.

When comparing the 2022 report to the one from 2021, it is evident that there has been more significant progress overall, with only minor changes observed in the cardiology & ENT department.



NEW DEVELOPMENTS

Emergency Department Renovation: To cater to the growing number of patients, our Emergency Department underwent a significant renovation to enhance capacity and improve patient care.

Orthopaedic Operation Theatre: We inaugurated a state-of-the-art Orthopaedic Operation Theatre, equipped with advanced facilities for orthopaedic procedures.

Laparoscopy and Arthroscopy Unit: The addition of this unit allows us to offer minimally invasive surgeries, ensuring faster recovery and reduced discomfort for patients.

High Dependency Unit (HDU): IQRAA HOSPITAL introduced a four-bedded High Dependency Unit (HDU) to provide specialized care for critically ill patients.

Admission and Discharge Counter: We introduced a streamlined admission and discharge process, ensuring a hassle-free experience for patients and their families.

Psycho-Social and Antenatal Counselling: New services were launched to provide psycho-social and antenatal counselling, offering comprehensive care to our gynaecology patients.

Weekly IN Charger's Review Meeting: We initiated weekly meetings to review and enhance hospital operations, ensuring the highest standards of patient care.

Appointment of Permanent RMO: In response to feedback from our Emergency Department patients, we appointed a dedicated Resident Medical Officer (RMO) to improve patient care and address concerns.

Gynaecology Department Expansion: The gynaecology department expanded its team to three specialists, enhancing our capacity to serve patients.

MATERNITY DEPARTMENT HIGHLIGHTS:

Challenges and Solutions:

In July, it was observed that total maternity OP & IP collections declined, and total deliveries decreased to 70 due to Dr. Amina Beevi's absence. Strategies were discussed and planned for live public programs to attract patients and improve marketing efforts.

In December, an incident involving Dr. Shana parveen and a patient, Shailaja (mother of our reception staff), resulted in complications and a subsequent police complaint. This incident had a significant adverse impact on the maternity department, leading to a drop in patient numbers, particularly in OP and IP. To counter this situation, programs were charted.

COMMUNITY OUTREACH AND HEALTH CAMPS:

During the year, we conducted several health camps and community outreach programs to promote better healthcare awareness. Some of the key initiatives include:

- In 19 th January we had conducted public awareness programme about nutrition during pregnancy by clinical diatition Mrs fida jabir supported by gynecologist Dr Rinsath and Dr shana

However, as we review recent developments, we are encouraged by a glimmer of hope that suggests a promising turnaround for FY 2023-2024. During the past financial year, we encountered a series of challenges that impacted our hospitals' performance. These challenges included a decline in patient visits, the departure of key medical personnel, and external factors such as the ongoing pandemic.

8.(1) IQRAA COMMUNITY CLINIC KALLAI

Iqraa community clinic kallai serves as a beacon of hope for the local residents of kallai. The clinic is equipped with fundamental medical facilities and supplementary services such as a laboratory, pharmacy, emergency nursing support, x-ray, ECG, and more. In the preceding fiscal year, the clinic effectively administered medical care to a total of 175,373 patients across various medical disciplines, averaging approximately 500 patients treated daily.

As part of our ongoing commitment to meeting the healthcare needs of our community, we made significant enhancements to our services in 2022-23:

- One of our notable initiatives during the year was the introduction of our family physician op, where patients can consult with a family physician for just Rs 10. This service is available from 8.30 AM to 4.00 PM.
- We changed the opening time of our laboratory to 6.00 AM, providing early access to vital diagnostic services for our patients.
- We extended our X-ray services to Sundays, ensuring accessibility to essential diagnostic imaging on weekends.
- In line with our commitment to community health, we conducted several medical camps
 (Renal screening camp, gynecology camp, pulmonology camp etc.) These camps provided free
 consultations and screenings.

FUTURE OUTLOOK

We are actively seeking a new building due to the unavailability of space for further development.

- USG SERVICES: We plan to introduce USG services to provide advanced diagnostic capabilities to our patients
- PHYSIOTHERAPY SERVICES: Recognizing the importance of rehabilitation and physical therapy, we plan to introduce physiotherapy services
- Increasing Observation Bed Numbers: We recognize the importance of observation facilities for our patients, therefore, we plan to increase the number of observation beds.

8.(3) IQRAA COMMUNITY CLINIC, PALAZHI

IQRAA Community clinic Palazhi started its services on June 2020. We have departments such as pediatrics, family medicine, gynecology dermatology, Ent, ortho, pulmonology, general surgery with a total strength of 15-18 staffs (including housekeeping, trainees) working in different departments. In this year we extended our casualty from two bedded observation to six bedded, much free and easy to accommodate patients. along with that we also started our X-RAY from October 2022.

In the month November 2022 to March 2023 there was lesser OP as compared to preceding months, this trend is almost same for past three years. The major part of the total op is consulted by RMO's. There is a monthly average of 5600 patients, with a large flow of patients from the month June 2022 to October 2022. The lowest collection was in April 2022,

8.(4) MSS IQRAA MEDICAL CENTRE ADIMALI

We had one Physican and 2 MOs initially with a 2 bedded casualty. As the time progress the number of patients attending the OP and patients who need emergency services has increased thereby there was a plan to expand the casualty with more beds. So renovation of the old physiotherapy building was started and new casualty was started functioning from 27-8-2022. Meanwhile Physiotherapy department was shifted to the newly constructed building. Since the number of patients were increased Inpatient department was started followed by initiation of Night shift for the casuality, Lab and pharmacy. New medical officer was also appointed to the casuality. We are glad and proud that Our Institution obtained labour License on April 3' 2022


Our Laboratory department was expanded with Fully automatic machine

8.(5) IQRAA AL KARAMA COMMUNITY CLINIC VELLAMUNDA


The outpatient numbers have been inconsistent throughout the year. The highest number of OP has been reported in july 2022. From the beginning to the end of this year, the clinic has been running without profit.



A family physician has joined in july in order to add service of an MD doctor. A general surgeon has also joined the team in the month of august. And then we hired an additional orthopedic doctor to increase the consultant services to two days in a week. Rented out an electrolyte analyzer machine for lab in december, which helped in smooth functioning of the lab procedures. ENT endoscopy has started in february for better ENT opd services. We have conducted several medical camps in the nearest areas of our clinic. We have provided discount cards for auto drivers and neighbors and conducted a free medical camp as a part of our 1st anniversary. And also we have done a kidney screening test on kidney day and gave awareness about kidney disorders. For popularizing these rvices provided by us, we have done somany advertisements through medias. We have started procedures for launching an x-ray unit in the clinic. Unfortunately we can't proceed the further steps for the same because of the nonprofit condition of the clinic. The main challenge faced by us is that the clinic is situated slightly far from the town, so people can't approach us easily. Also we have shortage in various specialist doctors, hence there is a fall in new outpatient counts. Our plan for coming year includes, to uplift the clinic from nonprofit condition to profit by reducing the total expenses and strengthening our system and facilities.

8.(6) IQRAA COMMUNITY CLINIC KODUVALLY

The out patient numbers have been increased from 22 april to march 23 consistently the highest number of out patient has been reported in september 2022. From the beginning the clinic was running in loss but later on february back in profit and trying to maintain the same from there.



A dermatologist has joined in august and hence it was possible to provide services in the treatment of skin disorders. In september an ortho specialist has also joined to elaborate the ortho op. A general surgeon has joined and started his op from october and also we are providing pediatric consultant services all days in a week from october. In december we had a break through by starting specialty op in gastroenterology. That contributed to the total outcome of the clinic. An additional ENT doctor has also started services in our clinic from february. In may we have made a milestone by launching radiology department in our clinic. Which also give good returns for the clinic. We bought an electrolyte analyzer machine for lab in july. That helped a lot in the smooth functioning of the lab procedures. We have conducted several medical camps in the nearest areas of our clinic. Which created some impacts in popularizing our name in the society. As a part of kidney day we have conducted a free kidney screening test and gave awareness about the day to day increase of kidney diseases. Also we have provided discounts for patients as a part of the 1st anniversary of clinic. For popularizing the services provided by us, we have done so many advertisements through medias. That helps to create changes in the progress of our total outcome to a some extent. All the new additions we have made gratefully benefited the patient for the accurate

diagnosis and treatment. The main challenges faced by our clinic is based on our infrastructure like congested observation areas, lack of ramp or lift in the floors etc. Our plans for coming year include improving the service quality and facilities and thereby increases the inflow of the new patients and at the same time maintaining the consistency of op numbers through holding back the old patients with us. For that we must focus on infrastructure development that will contribute a lot for increasing facilities and also planning to launch additional specialty op's to provide better service in all areas.


IQRAA marked positive financial growth in the Financial Year 2021-22 compared to the previous years which helped to recover from the prior year's losses from the impact of Covid-19 and other factors.

We managed to achieve a revenue of INR 3129.56 million which is 50% higher than the previous financial year's revenue of INR 2092.83 million. This growth was also considerably higher than the growth achieved in the financial year 2019-2020 of 19% where IQRAA achieved a revenue of INR 1865.59 million compared to revenue of INR 1569.03 in the financial year 2018-2019. The revenue growth reduced in the financial year 2020-2021 due to the impact of COVID-19. But the effective management have resulted in achieving a higher growth in the financial year 2021-2022 as mentioned.

Notably, we achieved an increase of 60% in medicine sales and 54% in the hospital collection compared to the previous year. Hospital Collection reached INR 1745.59 million and Medicine sales reached INR 842.05 million.


Operating income in the 2021-2022 Financial Year was INR 2587.64 million compared to INR 1661.94 million in the previous Financial Year, providing growth of 55.70%. Other streams of income such as canteen collection, Indirect Income & Other Income also had a positive change of around 20% to 30%.



While comparing the prior financial performance, the revenue growth achieved in the financial year 2021-2022 is 2.62 time greater than the revenue growth of 19% achieved in the financial year 2019-2020.

Even though the revenue growth in the financial year reduced to 12%, it was mainly due to the negative impact of COVID-19. But we managed to secure a higher revenue growth in 2021-2022 than the revenue growth of previous two financial years combined


Consolidated EBITDA

EBITDA for the 2021-2022 financial year is INR 184.00 million compared to INR -17.74 million during 2020-2021 which is a remarkable increase of INR 201.74 million. This positive EBITDA means that we are profitable at an operating level. It provides service and sells products higher than the cost to make or provide.

The negative EBITDA in the 2020-2021 financial year was due to the impact of COVID-19 which affected the revenue. But the increase achieved in the financial year 2021-2022 helped to mitigate the same.


USG Scanning Machine


X-Ray Machine

Outlet-2









QUALITY & PATIENT SAFETY DEPARTMENT

Introduction

Quality of care is the degree to which health services for individuals and populations increase the likelihood of desired health outcomes. It is based on evidence-based professional knowledge (WHO)

Quality health care can be defined in many ways but there is growing acknowledgement that quality health services should be:

- Effective providing evidence-based healthcare services to those who need them;
- Safe avoiding harm to people for whom the care is intended; and
- People-centred providing care that responds to individual preferences, needs and values.

An Overview of Achievements

The year 2022 was a year of Quality Insights & Healthcare Excellence for IQRAA Hospital & particularly for Quality & Patient Safety department.

NABH inspection of our hospital was scheduled on the 25th, 26th and 27th of March 2022. The three-day inspection was eventful with the guidance and valuable insights of the NABH assessors. After the thorough review of the assessors, we were granted the hospital NABH accreditation on the 30th of June 2022.

Similarly, Blood bank inspection was on the 16th and 17th of April 2022. Report of their findings were issued by the NABH. The suggested corrective actions were implemented and submitted. We received our blood bank accreditation on the 26th of May 2022.

13 DEPARTMENTAL HIGHLIGHTS 2022

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INCIDENTS REPORTED

In the year 2022, a total of 953 incidents were reported at IQRAA Hospital.



All the near-miss and adverse events were addressed within 48 hours of time and the sentinel events were addressed within 24 hours

WORLD PATIENT SAFETY DAY 2022

Patient safety day was celebrated on the 17th of September. 'Medication Safety' was the theme for World Patient Safety Day 2022, with the slogan 'Medication Without Harm'.

The campaign calls on stakeholders to prioritise and take early action in key areas associated with significant patient harm due to unsafe medication practices.

HOSPITAL COMMITTEES

All the hospital committees were convened regularly throughout the year. The follow up works of each committee was done by the committee convener. The functioning of committees is reviewed periodically for their effectiveness by the management in the management review meet. For an effective review and for the reference of hospital staffs, the scope of every committee was uploaded in the HIS (In Apex Manual), detailing the purpose of the committee, members and their role, functions of the committee, frequency of meetings etc.

KEY PERFORMANCE INDICATORS

A KPI is a statistical measure of the performance of functions, systems or processes over time. Quality department monitors 32 mandatory quality indicators as per the NABH requirement. We added 36 more indicators to the list and at present, a total of 68 indicators are being captured to monitor the efficiency & performance of our organization.

14 BIOMEDICAL ENGINEERING DEPARTMENT

The discipline of Biomedical engineering is the integrating medium for the two great dynamic professions; Medicine and Engineering. It combines the design and problem solving skills of engineering with medical and biological sciences to help improve patient healthcare and quality of life of individuals. Today they act as the driving forces of cost control, utilisation, optimisation, regulatory requirements, patient safety and human error awareness and increasing complexity of technical environment.

Administration of medical equipment management is the prime responsibility of Biomedical Engineering Division in IQRAA HOSPITAL. The Department of Biomedical Engineering provides guidance and direction in the selection of medical equipments. It works with other departments to ensure proper working of equipments throughout the expected life, inventory, and proper information on equipments.


Maintenance and calibration of various Biomedical equipments whole their life cycle from preparation of specification till its condemnation after several years, attending breakdowns immediately for vital equipments in critical areas like operation theatres, ICUs, imaging modalities, maintenance of hospital medical gas supplies, etc are some of the responsibilities of the biomedical engineering division. Summary of the major activities of the dept are:

MEDICAL EQUIPMENT MANAGEMENT

Dept is managing a total of 2214 Bio medical Equipment installed at IQRAA Hospital and providing support to 960 equipment installed at different branch hospitals.

A total of 231 pieces of equipment have been installed this year, major equipment installations are in RADIOLOGY, DIALYSIS, GASTROSURGERY OT and ERCP.





Condemned equipment: 27 Unsafe and aged equipment are condemned and updated with new.

EQUIPMENT TRAINING PROGRAMS

Training programs: Total 87 user and 37 technical training programs are conducted for hospital staffs on the proper use and maintenance of medical equipment.

Provided 6M/1 YR Clinical Engineering training to post Biomedical Engineering diploma and degree holders to boost their skill and knowledge in this field. Total 21 trainees completed their training & 5 trainees undergoing training this year.

On the job Training/ Internship Training: As part of course requirement dept conducted internship training for 15 students from different Engineering colleges in South India.

SAFETY INSPECTION


As a part of safety inspection 18480 visits are done for high risk equipment as daily rounds & 698 equipment visit as monthly rounds to ensure all critical equipment are working properly.

PERIODIC PREVENTIVE MAINTENANCE AND CALIBRATION

- Total scheduled preventive maintenance in this year was 2844, out of this 99.9% preventive maintenance check up are completed in this period.
- Calibration: Total scheduled calibration was 1556, out of this 93% calibration are completed timely.


In this year total registered complaints are 2281 and out of this 99.9% complaints have been successfully resolved within this year.



QUALITY ASSURANCE AND PERFORMANCE METRICS

- Total 161 high risk complaints are registered from 116 equipment and the downtime for high risk equipment is 188.03 hours. Up time of the High risk equipment is 99.9% in this year.
- Total registered medium risk complaints are 1357 and the downtime for medium risk complaint is 111377.2 hours. Up time of the medium risk equipment is 99.9% in this year.
- Total registered low risk complaints are 761 and the downtime for low risk complaint is 43138.02 hours . Up time of the low risk equipment is 99.4% in this year.

BUDGET AND RESOURCE ALLOCATION

Total Biomedical maintenance cost for the equipment is 3.25 Cr which is categorized as spare parts cost: 98,37,557/-, AMC/CMC cost: 21199706/-, and service cost: 15,34,586/-.

By utilizing the resource, in house service saved 1.33 Cr in this year.

Expected maintenance cost for the coming year will be around 4.5 to 5 Cr.

Equipment having age more than 10 years are recommended to replace as early as possible which costs around 2.2 cr.

Conclusion: The annual report on medical equipment management concludes that efficient management of medical equipment is crucial for maintaining high standards of healthcare delivery. Throughout the year, we have successfully monitored and maintained equipment, ensuring they are in good working condition. We have also implemented cost-effective measures to optimize equipment utilization and minimize downtime. Looking ahead, continuous improvement and investment in technology will remain our focus to enhance patient care and operational efficiency.

15 BLOOD BANK

Igraa Hospital Blood Bank received the prestigious NABH accreditation on May 26, 2022. Blood Bank has successfully achieved accreditation from the National Accreditation Board for Hospitals and Health Care Providers (NABH). The NABH accreditation is a testament to the team's unwavering commitment to providing safe and high-quality blood transfusion services. The team is led by Dr. Sajitha.

Before the accreditation IQRAA blood bank has been licensed by the central license approving authority on 30th March 2019 which was renewed periodically. While this license ensured compliance with minimum standards, it primarily aimed to create an environment with minimum risk to health and safety. However, the absence of comprehensive standards in various critical areas led to several challenges in our operations.

CHALLENGES BEFORE ACCREDITATION

Stock Management: Prior to accreditation, there were no specific standards in place to maintain critical levels of blood stock and reagent stock. This posed potential risks of shortages and hindered our ability to respond swiftly to patient needs.

Quality Monitoring: Blood bank functions were not regularly monitored through the evaluation of quality indicators. Consequently, the Turnaround Time (TAT) for testing, collection, and processing was significantly delayed, impacting patient care.

Wastage: Inadequate regular monitoring and improper policies resulted in high wastage of packed red cells, leading to avoidable resource loss.

Donor Management: Donor deferrals and donor reactions were not systematically recorded, affecting donor safety and management.

Documentation: Documentation was not up to date, potentially compromising transparency and traceability of our operations.

Infrastructure and Equipment: Adequate backup machines were not available, which could have posed operational challenges in case of equipment failures.

Donor Engagement: A full-time social worker for pre-donation counselling, recruitment, motivation, and retention of voluntary donors was not fully available, impacting our ability to build a sustainable pool of donors.

Product Quality: Quality monitoring of blood products was not conducted on a regular basis, potentially affecting the quality of transfusions.

Procedural Standardisation: Uniformity in testing methods among staff members was lacking, increasing the risk of errors and discrepancies.

Guidelines and Training: There was no established massive transfusion protocol or uniform transfusion guidelines for the hospital, and proper training and competence assessment of staff members were not consistently carried out.

BENEFITS OF NABH BLOOD CENTER ACCREDITATION

Iqraa Hospital Blood Bank received the prestigious NABH accreditation on the 26th May 2022, Blood Bank has successfully achieved accreditation from the National Accreditation Board for Hospitals & Health care Providers(NABH). This accreditation is testament to our commitment to maintaining the highest standards of quality and safety in blood banking services.

THE IMPACT OF ACCREDITATION: A POSITIVE TRANSFORMATION

Automation in Immunohematology: Accreditation led us to transition from manual to automated processes in immunohematology, drastically reducing manual errors in testing and reporting while significantly improving turnaround times.

Enhancing Blood Collection: We are now planning to introduce a mobile blood collection facility, enabling us to conduct blood donation camps and increase voluntary blood donation, thus serving our community more effectively.

Safety Enhancement: Accreditation has prompted us to explore nucleic acid testing of blood donor samples, further enhancing the safety of blood products.

Clinical Laboratory Servics (CLS) of IQRAA have been successfully maintaining its NABL accreditation for the last decade. During the mentioned period the dept has undergone a successful reassessment and the accreditation was renewed for the coming 2 years.

CLS currently operates more than 850 number of tests under various departments like Clinical Biochemistry, Haematology, Microbiology, Pathology, Serology & Molecular Biology. During the last financial year, we catered around 392,882 patients and performed 1,383,312 tests. During the period we added more than 20 new tests in-house including HLA typing by NGS.

Programs conducted during the period:

- 1. World arthritis day (12-10-2022) collaborating with departments of General Medicine, Physical medicine and radiology.
- 2. An half day CME for Clinicians and Residents on the newer developments in Antimicrobial testing.

Newly installed instruments:

- 1. Haematology cell counter: Two units of Sysmex XN 1000
- 2. Urine analyser for Chemistry and Sedimentation: Two units of FUS 1000



18 IT DEPARTMENT

The IT team at Iqraa consists of 15 staff and the team manages and fulfills all the hardware, software and networking needs of the hospital. There are around 700 systems including the ones in the peripherals which are all connected through excellent network systems. It is ensured that the systems are well protected from internal and external attacks.

The Hospital Management software currently being used is SMART HMIS which was implemented in October 2018. The primary focus was to convert the hospital into a paperless hospital and to streamline the workflow of the hospital. The hospital software optimized administrative tasks like appointment scheduling, billing and inventory management which leads to improved operational efficiency. In the initial years, we were successful in converting around 75 % of the OP data to Electronic data.

During 2022-2023, the main focus was on establishing **EMR for IP patients.** The main objective for doing this was to

- Maintain accurate and up-to-date records of patients, including medical history, diagnoses, treatments and prescriptions.
- Improve patient care by providing access to critical patient information quickly, leading to better and more informed decision-making, especially in emergencies.
- Reduce the chances of errors in transcription, improving patient safety and minimizing risks.
- Support clinical research by providing a structured database of patient information for studies and trials. It also helps in monitoring and improving the quality of care provided.

The necessary changes were made to the software for making it easy for the doctors and nurses to input the data of the IP patients.

50+ laptops/tabs were made available at the nursing stations. The Wi-Fi connectivity was made more stable.

Training sessions were conducted on a regular basis to educate the staff about the features needed for implementing IP EMR.

The **Doctors' app** was launched to get the information of their patients and an option to send notes from the doctor's app to the nurses' station was developed.

We have been around 75 percentage successful in implementing EMR of IP patients and we are still working on full swing to complete the whole process.

There are total number of 3 In-charges, one in the old building and two in the new building with 6 floor supervisors to maintain 140 staffs in a 24 hr basis duty schedule. (Professional HK, S24 and Genesis)

Mission: is to achieve **excellence in cleanliness and infection control and Objective** is to maintain a **safe and clean hospital environment.**

Key Performance Metrics:

- Present key performance enhancement is done with the help of checklist and patient satisfaction survey results.
- Comparing to previous years, staffs are well motivated through classes and continuous support from the authorities.

Achievements:

- Each staff before joining for duty are Interviewed personally to have a direct communication with new staffs, then completes Vaccination, orientation classes and then joins for duty. This gives both the staff and the management an overall picture of the institution and its organizational structure.
- During the year, many changes were done in order to upgrade and enhance the process of cleaning like track records, checklist Eg:- A checklist for the changing of curtains was intro duced (as many complaints were received in the previous months) All monthly records should be mailed to the HOD at the end of each month.
- Continuing Staff induction program for hand hygiene and spill management were given within the department, Institution and by the supervisors.
- Best quality House Keeping Staff was honoured.
- Staffs are taken for a one day trip to Kodaikanal, Ooty.
- Conducted Onam and Annual day Programs in 2022.
- Challenges:- Uncontrolled number of bystanders in the hospital often makes the cleaning job difficult.
- No Area for washing and drying up of mops & mats and need janitor rooms in all floors.
- Solutions: Hospital management have granted a Washing machine for the exclusive use of the House Keeping Department.
- Have to find out a space for drying up of mops, mats, janitor rooms.
- Training:-Special training was given to the house keeping staffs by delegates from their respective companys.
- Environmental Sustainability: All equipments and cleaning solutions used are eco-friendly and environment friendly cleaning products.
- Compliance and Regulations: The Department complies with all relevant healthcare regulations, standards and safety protocols.
- Patient and Staff Feedback:

21 CLINICAL NUTRITION DEPARTMENT ANNUAL REPORT – 2022-2023

Over past decades, nutrition and nutritional care have gained importance among clinical and scientific experts. Increasing metabolic disorders and role of nutritional care in acute and chronic illness have paved way for designing of nutritional care pathway. Implementation of evidence based institutionalised nutrition care policy is linked with better patient outcome.

Clinical Nutrition Department aims to deliver evidence-based care. The department functions and duties are based on defined policy in par with existing Indian and International guidelines. The team of 6 qualified skilled professionals conduct the activities under the guidance of team lead. All In-patients are attended by dietitian for nutritional screening, followed by nutritional diagnosis, intervention and monitoring. Op patients are addressed on daily basis. The food service system is restricted to renal transplant recipients and enterally fed patients. Hence the intervention mainly focuses on nutrition counselling and education. We do have internal training programmes for uplifting and updating team members.

Critical care nutrition:

One of the milestones of Clinical nutrition department was the establishment and implementation of well-defined nutritional care policy for critically ill. Continuous feeding was initiated as part of policy introduction. Compliance of the policy was audited with the guidance from Quality and patient safety department. Two PDCA Cycle was done for the audit. The problems related to underfeeding was well addressed through providing bedside education to ICU staffs.

Training and Extension programmes:

Internship programmes are conducted by Clinical Nutrition Department to Undergraduate and Postgraduate students of Dietetics. Almost 30 students have successfully completed the internship programme in the year 2022-2023. Department have also opened its service for project guidance for PG students and 3 students have enrolled for the same.

Research:

Ongoing research work in critical care for understanding the efficacy of different formulas in sepsis enterally fed patients. Conducted study among critical care staff to understand the corelation between perceived stress and diet habits.

Community programmes and activities:

Conducted awareness sessions to residence associations, orphanages, old age homes, schools during various occasions like world health day, women's day, National Nutrition month etc. Developed video contents for public awareness in collaboration with media department.

22 IORAA FOR ALL :

IQRAA FOR ALL is the social outreach arm of IQRAA in helping and assisting poor patients in the comprehensive healthcare. In the past years IQRAA has strived to improve and improvise its philanthropic activities in all possible ways. In this past three years IQRAA since its inception works for providing accessible and affordable healthcare to the orphans, poor and needy. We are aimed at enabling the availability of high-quality medical services to the needy at basic cost and to help raise the funds for medical treatments using our channel to uphold the cause of humanity. It provided to deserving patients who meet the organization's eligibility criteria for financial assistance through socio-economic assessment. Depending on their socio-economic assessment, hospitals may provide financial assistance to patients as per the recommendation of the department of social work. The logos for the programs are launched on January 2023

1. IQRAA KIDNEY CARE (IKC)



IQRAA execute the kidney transplantation for the lowest rate in the entire country with the best possible facilities. Under this scheme, we have identified a few sponsors and are open to extending the sponsorship programme, for the deserving patients undergoing dialysis and transplant respectively. During the AY 2022-23 we have completed 231 transplants.

We also have an extended helping hand for the dialysis and transplant patients, not only for the patients of IQRAA hospital, but for all the poor patients of the region by issuing a special card, named ASHRAYA Health card.

Total discounts worth INR.9901615/- were extended to the 649 beneficiaries in the last year.

IORAA introduced first subsidised dialysis centre in Kerala and the treatment is provided for the lowest rate and in the last year we had 53674 beneficiaries.

AY 2022-23, we had 8702 dialysis / transplant beneficiaries from the same with an expenditure of Rs.5220034/- and in the periphery centres of IQRAA, 24336 dialysis patients benefitted from the scheme.

They will get 50% discount in hospital bills, investigations etc. And also 50% discount in doctors' consultation. Consultation of physiatrist is completely free of cost for paraplegic patients.

During the last year, we had 55 beneficiaries with an expenditure of Rs.34722/-.

Ullam- psychiatric rehabilitation programme



Ullam launched in the year 2022, it aims for Psychiatric rehabilitation to help individuals with persistent and serious mental illness to develop the emotional, social and intellectual skills needed to live, learn and work in the community with the adequate amount of professional support. We have a well versed multi disciplinary team which includes eminent psychiatrists, psychologists, social workers, nurses and other supportive staff. IQRAA provide discount and free treatment for the poor and destitute psychiatric patients. Last year, in 2022, there were 540 beneficaries to the scheme.


